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Lialka Motanka Workshop

In English, *lialka motanka* means "wrapped/reeled doll" (*lialka*=doll / *motaty*=to wrap or reel). This ancient Ukrainian doll was traditionally made by women and girls. It is made by wrapping together leftover scraps of fabrics and was never sewn or pierced. They could be decorated as simply or ornately as desired. The doll was not only a toy, but also a symbol of wisdom, a protectress of the family, a symbol of Mother Earth. Dolls were usually passed on from one generation to another, and so also symbolized a connection between generations.

Because a *lialka motanka* is not supposed to represent an identifiable person, it normally doesn't have a face (with eyes, mouth, nose, etc.). If you wish, you can make a cross-shaped design in place of a face. The cross symbolizes harmony of the spiritual (vertical) and earthly (horizontal) aspects of life.

Have any scraps of fabric at home? Make a *lialka motanka* for a friend or family member! Remember to think of well wishes or intentions when making the *lialka* so that those good thoughts get passed on to the recipient.

In this workshop, young artists will learn how to wrap their own *lialka motanka*.

- 1. Fabric for inside of head or batting (approx. size 12 x 7 in.)
- 2. White/Cream Fabric for Head & Body (approx. size 14 x 14 in.)
- 3. White/Cream Fabric for Arms (approx. size 10 x 4 in.)
- 4. Colorful Skirt Fabric (approx. size 6 x 7 in.)
- 5. Colorful Apron Fabric (approx. size 4.5 x 2.5 in.)
- 6. Ribbon to attach the Apron (approx. size 9-10 inches)
- 7. Colorful Headscarf Fabric (approx. size 12 x 12 in.)
- 8. Thread to secure head, arms, body (natural color)
- 9. Thread to decorate head (any color)
- 10.Scissors
- 11. Optional: Yarn for hair, small flowers for hair, beads for necklace
